

A STUDY ON THE SOCIAL STUDIES TEACHERS' HABITS OF FOLLOWING MEDIA (VAN CITY SAMPLE)

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Abstract

The aim of this study is to determine the social studies teachers' habits of the following media tools. In this study, interview method was used to gather required data. In the scope of the research, the interviews were conducted with 117 Social Studies Education Teachers working in schools affiliated to the Ministry of Education in Van Province in the 2015-2016 education year by using "The Media Following Form" developed by İnan (2010). The data gathered through the teacher's interviews were analyzed by descriptive analysis applying frequency and percentage. Having evaluated the research results in general it seen that the majority of the teachers watch Tv between 1-3 hours a day; mostly follow news program in Tv; the half of the teacher who attend the research listen radio 1 hours a day and the others never listen music; in general they listen educational and cultur programs in the radio; the half of the teacher read newspaper everyday; the daily using internet time is 1-3 hours; the teachers use internet especially to reach the daily news and course/educational purpose; they use the mobile phone connecting internet except for communication
