



INVESTIGATION OF THE THOUGHTS OF THE HEARING IMPAIRED CHILDREN'S MOTHERS CONCERNING THEIR RIGHTS

Abstract

It is not possible for individuals with disabilities to benefit from human rights conventions in some circumstances. The United Nations Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities, is important for the disabled people and for their families to benefit from fundamental rights and freedoms, for minimizing their disadvantage and for social harmony. In this context, the research aimed to determine the opinions of the hearing-impaired children about the rights they and their children possess. The study group was determined using objective sampling methods as criteria sampling. The research was carried out in the city center of Kırşehir with mothers with hearing impaired children. Interview technique was used from qualitative research methods. Semi-structured "Interview Form" developed by researchers was used in the study. The results of the interviews conducted with the mothers included in the survey were analyzed and sub-themes were formed. Participant codes were determined according to these sub-themes and percentages of the participant who gave opinions about each determined sub-theme were given. In addition, findings were quoted directly.
