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INVESTIGATION OF SINGLE PARENT RELATIONSHIPS IN ADOLESCENTS PERCEIVED LONELINESS AND ANGER

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Abstract

The aim of this study was to investigate the relationship between perceived levels of single-parent loneliness and anger expression of adolescents.

Research has been prepared in relational model of the descriptive research model. Relational scan patterns, the exchange between two or more presence with a large number of variables and / or research aimed at determining the degree models. The study sample is located on the Anatolian side of Istanbul, he lost one of his parents, because the parents are divorced or a different reason than adolescents with parental formed separate from anyone.

According to the findings of the study; single-parent relationship between the level of perceived loneliness of adolescents with trait anger and anger expression were significantly positively.

Results of the study contains important consequences for psychological counseling and guidance field. According to these findings, inferences can be made in single-parent will need to loneliness and anger management counseling services. Work interventions for those students who are single parents at an early age is important to reduce aggression and violent behavior in adulthood.
