

A STUDY ON GRADUATE THESIS AND MATERIALS CONCERNING THE KANUN INSTRUMENT: CONTENT ANALYSIS STUDY

Abstract

This study is a content analysis study in which the theses indexed in the YÖK National Thesis Center related to kanun instrument and the articles available from the "Google Academic" search engine are analyzed in terms of various variables. For this purpose, 24 dissertations and 11 articles related to kanun instrument and Turkish were examined. The results of the research are organized according to the sub-problems, presented in a descriptive form as frequency and percentage table. As a result of the study, most of the post-graduate publications related to kanun instrument were made in the graduate thesis, most of the publications were made in 2017 and when the distribution of the publications according to the gender was examined, the majority of the male researchers formed the publications according to the universities and the distribution of the publications. Haliç University and Istanbul Technical University Data analysis method in which the vast majority of the postgraduate dissertations and articles are made using "descriptive patterns" and "qualitative methods" and "document analysis" is used as the data collection tool in the majority of the studies the "descriptive analysis" method is used more frequently, the number of samples indicating the number of samples is 7-8, it has been determined that kanun player constitute the majority of the sample.
