

## TURKISH VERSION OF ADOLESCENT MONEY ATTITUDE SCALES: THE STUDY OF VALIDITY AND RELIABILITY

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### Abstract

The aim of this research is to examine the validity and reliability of the Turkish version of the Adolescent Money Attitude Scales (Beutler & Gudmunson, 2012). Participants were 330 high school students. Results of confirmatory factor analysis demonstrated that this scale yielded two factors (Entitlement and Conscientiousness), as original form ( $\chi^2= 53.76$ ,  $df= 31$ ,  $RMSEA= .047$ ,  $GFI= .97$ ,  $AGFI=.94$   $CFI= .98$ ,  $IFI= .98$ , and  $SRMR= .050$ ). Cronbach alpha internal consistency reliability coefficients of the scale were .77 for entitlement, .66 for conscientiousness. Corrected item-total correlations ranged .32 to .68. Thus Adolescent money attitude can be used as a valid and reliable instrument.
