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THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS' PEER RELATIONS AND THEIR ATTITUDE ABOUT SCHOOL

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Abstract

The purpose of this study is to define the relation between high school students' attitudes about school and their opinions about peer relations. The sample of the study was figured with relational survey model and it was carried out at Anatolian and Vocational high schools in Akçakoca district in Düzce province. Study group consists of 358 students who are volunteers. Research data were collected via "School Attitude Scale" and "Friendship Qualities Scale". On data analysis, mean, standard deviation and correlation analysis were used. According to the results of the study, it has been confirmed that students' attitudes about school are at low level, friendship qualities levels are at medium-level and also there is a negative directional and meaningful relation at a low-level between high school students' attitudes about school and their opinions about peer relations.
