

A ROTA OFFER FOR FIELD WORK IN GEOGRAPHY EDUCATION: THE ROUTE OF ISPARTA GEOGRAPHY AND TOURISM

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Abstract

Field work is one of the most important teaching methods in geography and it is not possible to divide geography science and education from each other. On the other hand, field work contributes geography education in the view of practical knowledge. The aim of the research is to present information to the geography educators about sample field work route and research work related with teaching physical geography that they can benefit. Thus, the teachers who know about the field are aimed to use this knowledge in their lessons. With this aim, 12 locations in total that convenient for educational field work and determined as work area in Isparta at center and around have separated in two routes and be reported. The locations included in the route of this study are Eğirdir Lake, Aksu River, Kovada Lake, Siant Paul Road, Kasnak Meřesi Forest Area (Yukarı Gökdere), Gölcük Crater Lake, Yalvaç-Psidia Antiochia, Yazılı Canyon, Davraz Mountain, İnsuyu Cave, Sagalassos Antic City and Kapıkaya Antic City. With this study, the places above have been evaluated as a route and presented their geographical features in the view of academic studies and tourism sector.
